



Jewish Wedding Ceremony Seating Chart

(Please fill in names for both Bride's and Groom's sides)*

Bride's Side

Each seat has 1 field for first name and 1 field for last name. Fill in both. Press "tab" on your keyboard to move to next seat.

Groom's Side

*Note: In Jewish ceremonies, Parents stand at altar with Bride and Groom, and Grandparents are seated as such:

First row Left (starting at first aisle seat, moving left)—Groom's Grandparents, Stepparents and Spouses

First row Right (starting at first aisle seat, moving right)—Bride's Grandparents, Stepparents and Spouses

Alternate seating—Stepparents and Spouses may sit on second or third row.

Other family members/VIPs also may sit on second or third row.

Flower Girl and Ring Bearer may sit on second or third row with parents/guardians, if not standing during ceremony.

(There are many variations of seating preferences, so create a seating chart that suits your needs.)
